### Governance

#### Indicator

Do you agree: 'The community should retain a strong influence in any future vision for the neighbourhood'

#### Finding

311 people responded to this question (219 after the weighting process) and the vast majority either strongly agree or agree with this statement, meaning that the community should have a strong influence in any future vision for the neighbourhood; these answers makes up 89.2% of the total.

On the other hand, there are more people who either don't have an opinion about or didn't answer (7.0%) than people who either strongly disagree or disagree (3.8%).


#### Theoretical assumption

Do you have any comments you'd like to make about governance?

### Finding

41 people responded to this question and, on the right, you can see the outcomes of a keyword analysis.

Local residents identify as crucial the role that community shall play with regards to current unmet needs and future development of their neighbourhood; in addition, the local community's involvement is a particularly sensible matter for what concerns future housing and employment opportunities provision within the Camley Street and Elm Village area.

### Theoretical assumption

This indicator shows local residents' involvement and desire to take part in the future decisions regarding their neighbourhood.
